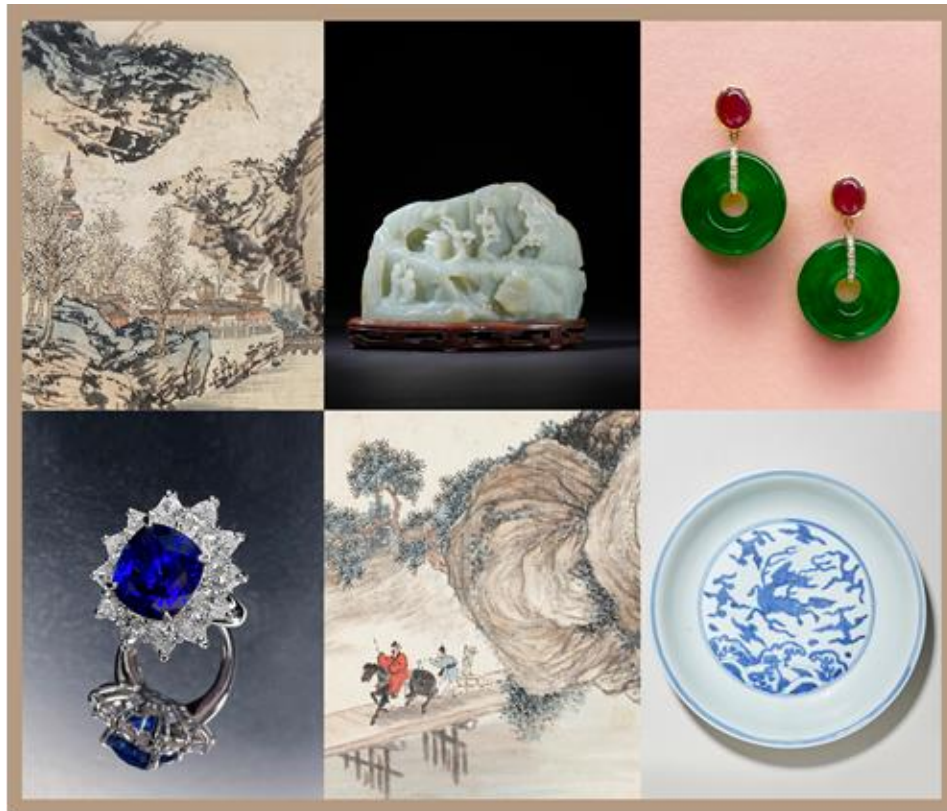

### Chinese Paintings and Calligraphy

The Chinese Paintings and Calligraphy sale will take place on 18 December at 10am. It will lead by **Tian Min Lou Collection** totaling 180 lots with no reserve prices. Highlights from **Tian Min Lou** are **Pu Ru’s *Landscape*** and **Huang Zhou’s *A Young Lady*** painted in the 1960s. Other important works offer in the sale includes **Zhang Daqian’s *Ink Lotus*** from **Seto Jutarō Collection**, precious works from the **Dan Han Lou Collection** purchased in the 1980s and 1990s from Guangzhou Antique, and nearly a hundred pieces of fine works from an **Important Hong Kong Private Collection**, of which the majority are purchased in the 1980s and acquired directly from the painters.

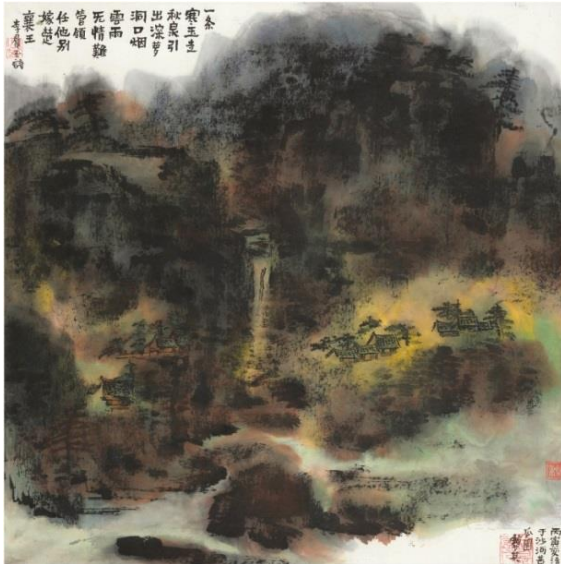

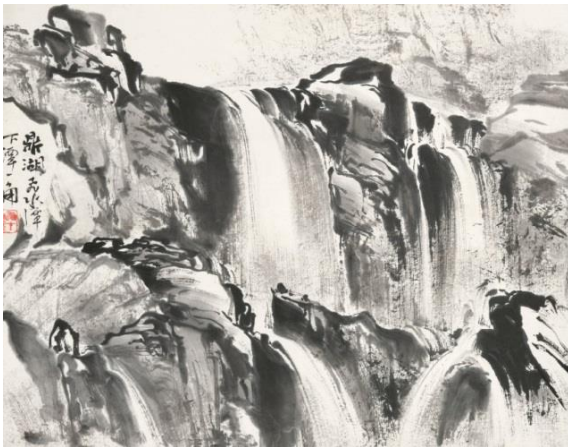
